Experience Music Project: Period 3

What are we learning this week?

Students will start on a music history unit-this week looking at the Medieval and Renaissance Eras.

Why are we learning this?

Music history is important to realize the development of music and how it has shifted throughout the ages.

How do we know we are learning this?

Students will provide specific examples of literature from these eras, identify them by listening, and discuss historical factors that led to musical changes
